Domestic projects

Intergenerational solidarity in farm families

On the basis of reviewed and analysed literature, the fieldwork in selected villages in Prekmurje (Slovenia) (34 interviews with members of multi-generational farm families) was carried out. Collocutors also filled in evaluation tests on their quality of life and family relations.

Evaluation of a psychoeducation and pharmacotherapeutic effects in patients with bipolar mood disorder:

The project was completed. Neuropsychological assessment of selective attention, behaviour inhibition, social cognition, and clinical scales for mania, depression, impulsivity and affective temperaments revealed that several aspects of cognitive and psychosocial functioning in the group of bipolar patients (n = 90) considerably improved after attendance at psychoeducational programme, while pharmacotherapeutic different approaches did not differ significantly among themselves regarding their effects on general cognitive and psychosocial functioning.

Social constructions of migrant statuses and their impact on the processes of selection and integration of migrants:

Primary and secondary sources and current national and EU policy pertaining to the selection and categorisation of migrants were analysed.

On this basis, the fieldwork phase, to be carried out in 2010, was designed.

International projects and cooperation

Electronic standard coding and mapping of services for long-term care (eDESDE-LTC): created is new updated version of the Slovenian e-DESDE-LTC instrument with a qualitative analysis of the utility and suitability of instrument in the field of long term care in Slovenia. In this regard, in Slovenia were organised two meetings with eight representatives of leading experts in this field.
