OCCUPATIONAL HEALTH PROBLEMS IN THE GROUP OF FARMERS AND FARMWORKERS

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OBJECTIVES

Farmers and farmworkers are vulnerable to various **health problems** due to their **occupational exposure to safety**, **health**, **environmental**, **biological**, and **respiratory hazards**. In the present study, we examined the psychosocial and health conditions of farmers and farmworkers, from their perspectives.

METHODE

We conducted a complex analysis of socio-demographic and health conditions in the group of farmers and farmworkers.


A self-assessment questionnaire was developed to analyse the occupational health problems of farmers and farmworkers. Participants were asked to describe their health problems an well-being the last 12 months.


The survey was conducted from May to December 2021.


PARTICIPANTS N = 408


The 51- to 65-year-old group dominated (33%).

24% of the participants had secondary school education and 28% had tertiary education.









60% of participants were satisfied or very satisfied with their state of health.

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CONCLUSION

Despite serious health problems and excessive stress, many farmers and farmworkers tend to deny their health problems and do not seek help, which can lead to a deterioration of their mental, physical, and social health.
